

North Surrey Natter Visit to Wings Museum

Thursday 13th June 2024

The north Surrey Natter is visiting the Wings Museum on 13th June. The day will start with a lunch time Natter and lunch followed by the museum visit early afternoon.



The Wings Museum is a fascinating collection of aircraft, recovered relics and wartime displays. Our visit will include a tour of the museum workshop where aircraft restoration projects are undertaken and currently includes part of a B25 Mitchell Bomber.

The Wings Museum includes displays featuring:

- The Bomber Campaign
- Fighter Offensive
- D Day and Beyond
- The Home Front, Blitz and Battle of Britain
- WWll Radios



The museum actively recovers crashed WWII aircraft and includes some interesting displays. It has recently acquired a DUKW amphibious vehicle.
