

## M.G.CAR CLUB (South East Centre) AUTUMN NAVISCAT 6<sup>th</sup> October 2024

## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- The MG Car Club (South East Centre) will organise a Navigational Scatter Rally on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2024. The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations. The Motorsport UK permit has been applied for, and route liaison work carried out.
- All entrants, including passengers, are now required by Motorsport UK to hold a RS Clubman's Licence obtainable free of charge from <a href="https://rsclubman.motorsportuk.org/">https://rsclubman.motorsportuk.org/</a>, or by post using the application form. In the event that entrants have not obtained a RS Clubmans license, they can complete an application form on the day and hand in to the organisers before the event (if 'YES' is entered to either of the application form medical questions, you can only enter as a passenger/navigator on the day).
- The event will be run using the 1:50000 series Ordnance Survey map, Landranger sheet 188 Maidstone & Royal Tunbridge Wells. A recent version of this map, plus a writing implement for marking points on the map and filling in answers to the questions, will be the minimum that is required. Coloured stickers (or other useful devices) for marking are up to the individual teams. A Romer, for measuring grid references on the map, is available free of charge at the start.
- The event will start from the Coblands Garden Centre Café map reference 495556. Signing in will take place between 10.00am and 11.45am and any competitor not signed on by then may be deemed a non-starter. The event will start at 11.0am and finish by 2.30pm at The Little Brown Jug PH. The maximum mileage for the event is estimated as 80.
- Participants will be required to visit a selection of locations defined by map references, and at each place will need to answer a question related thereto. The list of locations will be handed out at 11.0am. Participants will not be required to visit all locations, and only the 30 best answers will count towards the final score, i.e. no more than 75% of the total number of locations. Majority of points will not be visible from the car.
- 6 Classes will be as follows:
  - A Pre-1955 cars
  - B All MGBs
  - C MGs from 1955-1995
  - D MGs from 1995 on
  - E Non-MGs.

The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes if necessary.

- 7 Awards will be as (for example) follows:
  - First MG
  - First in class (subject to 4 entries in class).
  - Second in class (subject to 6 entries in class).
  - Novice award
- It is preferred that entries should be made pre-event to minimise paperwork on the day, although on the day entries will be accepted. The entry fee is £12. per car and should be submitted with the entry form. Entry fees should preferably be paid by electronic payment but if this is not possible cheques can be forwarded to the secretary of the meeting. Once the completed Entry Form together with copies of the driver and passengers RS Clubmans License and event entry fees have been accepted by the organisers, the entrant will be given an entry number. If paying by cheque, enough time must be allowed for postage/receipt and payment verification.

- Global Positioning Systems are not allowed. The penalty for use is disqualification. Entrants with a three-adult occupancy in the car will incur a 10% penalty on the final score, whilst four adults will incur a 15% penalty.
- The event is untimed other than having an overall time period for completion. Competitors must at all times full comply with the Road Traffic Act/Highway Code whilst driving on the highway.
- Drivers should ensure that their car insurance will cover this event as technically it is a Motorsport UK classified Rally event. No insurance company has refused to insure for this type of event because it is on public roads with no element of timing or speed and entrants must comply with the Road Traffic Act and Highway Code apply at all times.
- This event is open to entrants from invited Clubs not affiliated to MSUK and non-MGCC club members of the public to take part, though they cannot officiate. Once they have signed on, they are deemed to be a member of MGCC for that day only, as far as Motorsport UK and their insurance cover is concerned and must comply with MGCC Rules and Policies.)
